Course Description

The General Safety Awareness (GSA) program provides work guidelines that employees should know and follow. The program highlights rules of conduct, personal protective equipment, personal hygiene, and safe work practices.

In particular, workers are introduced to the proper techniques and practices for lifting heavy objects, painting and staining, grooming landscapes, operating power tools, using gas-powered equipment, working with ladders, confined space awareness, handling hazardous materials, fueling machinery, and maintaining personal hygiene.

It is the employer's responsibility to ensure that every reasonable precaution is taken to protect a worker. However, it must be realized that it is the young worker's responsibility to act with *due diligence* in all work situations. In other words, regardless of age, all employees should work with care and attention to safety.
